



MBN 2013 CREATING AN AGREEMENT

A MAJOR FACILITY RESTORATION OCCURS THAT ESSENTIALLY FULFILLS THE PURPOSE OF THE PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT.

Facilities: \$12.35M philanthropic gift, interior, exterior, slave quarters, museum

Exhibits: \$4M all new exhibits, themes and experiences


Artifacts: NPS curators worked to conserve or restore more than 1,000 historic objects and acquired 1,300 antiques or reproductions, including several artifacts associated with African American history which will be displayed for the first time.

Dialogic, audience center, move away from historic home "furniture" tours




A PARTNERSHIP CHANGES




R&D AND PLANNING

WHEN CONFLICT EXISTS

- From a foundation about a building to programs.
 - Doesn't sound like entrepreneurship but it provides a lens for risk.
 - What's the new product, services, or process.
 - Risk avoidance, reduce, share/transfer, retention/accept
- Conflict management and the use of facilitation in the life cycle





Spectrum of alternative dispute resolution choices (MBN facilitation)

- NPS passive to facilitated engagement. Use of CADR. Conflict, controversial, complex.
- Risks: from caterpillar to chrysalis is the pupal stage, it is a nonfeeding stage
- Think about that. An organization that isn't feeding itself is at risk of failure. Fail faster.


